## Biophysics in the Department of Electrical and Computer Systems Engineering – a personal perspective

David joined Doug Lampard as a PhD student in 1971 and worked in the Biophysics Laboratory in the area of muscle physiology. Following the completion of his PhD in 1977 he spent some years in Boston with Fred Julian before returning to the Department as a Lecturer. Over the years he has been promoted through the ranks, becoming a Professor in 2003 and Head of the Department in 2005 and 2006. His sabbatical periods have usually been spent in the Boston area. He has made significant contributions in the area of muscle physiology. In 1991 he was both promoted to a Readership and awarded a DSc (from the Faculty of Science). The Dean of Science reported the "receipt of very favorable reports indeed from the examiners". He still appears occasionally in repeats on Beyond 2000.
