**From milliwatts to Gigawatts**

**From the Bionic Ear to a Sustainable Energy Plan for Australia**

Peter Seligman joined the bionic ear project at Melbourne University in 1979. He has been the key electronics designer of the prosthesis through seven generations of its manifestation. He transferred to Cochlear, the company that manufactures and supports the ear, in 1983 and retired from there in 2009. In addition to his milliwatt work with the bionic ear he has had a lifelong interest in sustainable energy projects and since retirement from Cochlear has pursued these interests with vigour. Peter was awarded a Doctorate in Engineering from Melbourne University in 2009.
